Students' Difficulties in Comprehending English Texts: An Investigation at State Madrasah Aliyah in Palembang

Reni Oktafia (12250111)

ABSTRACT

This study was conducted to find out the students' difficulties in comprehending English texts and the factors causing students' difficulties in comprehending English texts. The participants of this study were the students of MAN 3 Palembang. In this study, I chose the participants by using purposeful sampling. There were 28 twelfth grade students selected based on the teacher's information and students' score. In this research, I used qualitative study with case study design. Data collection technique used in this research was interview. From the analysis of interview, I found that the students' difficulties were new vocabularies, lack of vocabularies, and vocabularies used in texts were too high. Besides, the students also had difficulty in interpreting the meaning of words, did not understand about verb, adjective, grammar, and tenses. Furthermore, they were also confused to understand the texts were too long. They could not comprehend the sentences. Moreover, they got difficulties to memorize the content of texts and did not know how to read. In addition, they also got complicated, dizzy and sometimes it mixed up with frustration when they got difficulties in comprehending English texts. In the aspects of reading comprehension, I found that the students had difficulty in identifying the main idea, identifying supporting details, finding the meaning of words in English texts, distinguishing between fact and opinion, making logical inferences, and summarizing on the passage of reading text. Meanwhile, the factors causing students' difficulties were limited vocabularies knowledge, lack of fluency, lack familiarity with the subject matter, difficulty level of the text, weak verbal reasoning, problems in processing information, and problems in recalling information after reading. Therefore, I hoped that the teachers can find new methods or strategies to help the students in comprehending English texts.
