

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS**

#### **5.1 CONCLUSIONS**

From the data analysis, I concluded that there were three conclusions drawn in this study based on the findings and interpretations. From the data analysis in chapter 4, the p-value was .579 which was higher than 0,05. As the result, it was found that there was no statistically correlation between students' learner autonomy and their reading comprehension achievement.

Second, because of the correlation does not exist between student's learner autonomy and their reading comprehension achievement, the researcher could not continue this study to the second research problem. So, it is worth saying that student's learner autonomy does not give any influence to students' reading comprehension achievement.

Consequently, it can be inferred that students with bad learner autonomy do not guarantee that he/she is bad in reading comprehension achievement. In that case, it can be other factors had relation in pursuing students' learner autonomy and reading comprehension achievement.

#### **5.2 SUGGESTIONS**

Based on the conclusions above, suggestions in this study were provided for the students, lecturers, and other researchers who are interested in the future research. First, to the students, since reading ability of the students is important,

they have to be aware and explore more on their own role so they can strengthen their strangeness in many aspects of their life.

Second, to the lecturers, especially in English teacher, it is suggested that all the lecturers need to consider solution to develop of students reading comprehension achievement. This study may reveal the current conditions and teaching learning outcomes especially in reading subject.

Finally, for future researchers who have interest in this subject, it can be resource for them to conduct the same research in different sample. the writer suggests other future researcher need to promote the local and target language cultural contents in reading text for students who learn English as a foreign language as like Indonesia.
