### Appendix D The Result of Classification of Types of Adverb of Manner Errors

#### RATER CONSULTATION FORM

#### I. Classification of Types of Adverb of Manner Errors

To find out adverb of manner errors made by the tenth grade students of MA Al-Fatah Palembang, this research uses error classifications based on surface tructure taxonomies by Dulay, Burt and Krashen (1982) which contain omission, addition, misformation and misordering.

#### 1. Omission Error

It is characterized by the absence of an item that must appear in a well-formed utterance.

For example: She plays together with her friends cheerful\*. Instead of She plays together with her friends cheerfully.

#### 2. Addition Error

It is the opposite of omission. It is characterized by presence of an item, which must not appear in a well-formed utterance.

For example: Ryan walks fastly. Instead of Ryan walks fast.

#### 3. Misformation Error

It is characterized by the use of wrong form of morpheme or structure.

For example: My mother looks at me angryly. Instead of My mother looks at me angrily.

### 4. Misordering

It is characterized by the incorrect placement of a morpheme or group of morpheme in an utterance.

For example: He did his homework laziyl last night. Instead of He did his homework lazily last night.

## II. Indentification of Adverb of Manner Errors

There are 503 errors on the use adverb of manner made by the tenth grade students of MA Al-Fatah Palembang. I provide all types of adverb of manner errors and correct adverb of manner words in the table below. The errors are classified based on surface tructure taxonomies by Dulay, Burt and Krashen (1982). There are 159 omission errors, 138 addition errors, 205 misformation errors, and 1 misordering error.
